

Slovenian Nouns – 2

Construct a lexicon and grammar to account for the data below. Don't posit more classes than you need to. The data can be accounted for with only two classes. Where two sets of nouns behave differently in a way that might suggest a third class, ask yourself whether the difference(s) is/are predictable (from their phonological or semantic properties).

‘o’ represents [ɔ]. [x] is a voiceless velar fricative. [j] is a palatal glide. [ŋ] is a palatal nasal.

“*” indicates forms omitted because they would complicate this problem unnecessarily.
