Interstate Commerce Commission and Agricultural Department (farmers)

Where?

Iowa

When?

1953

What?

ICC in charge of interstate shipping of manufactured products;

ICC claims frozen eviscerated chickens are 'manufactured products

Farmers claim frozen eviscerated chickens are an 'agricultural' commodity; hence exempt from ICC shipping requirements

Why?

 Congress had intended that farmers be exempted from ICC-type regulations
