ICC v. Kroblin

Who ?

Interstate Commerce Commission and
Agricultural Department (farmers)

Where ?

Iowa

When ?

1953

What ?

ICC in charge of interstate shipping of
manufactured products;
ICC claims frozen eviscerated chickens are
'manufactured products'
Farmers claim frozen eviscerated chickens
are an 'agricultural' commodity; hence
exempt from ICC shipping requirements

Why ?

- Congress had intended that farmers be
exempted from ICC-type regulations
