Choose one article published in the last 7 years (2000 or later) that is related to some topic discussed in class. If you're worried at all about comprehensibility or applicability (or have any other questions!), don't hesitate to see me for help.

- 2) Go online to the Web of Science to find a *more recent* article that responds to the first study you've selected.
- Back at the library gateway (http://www.library.uiuc.edu), click on "Online Research Resources".
- Type "Web of Science" into the field that reads "Words in resource name or title of e-journals"
- Click on any of the links provided to access the Web of Science (except the humanities one)
- Click on "Search by bibliographic information"
- Click on "Search for articles that cite an author or article that you specify
- Enter the relevant information, and select an article (making sure it responds directly to the first article you selected)
- 3) Read both articles and write a review of the literature. What this means is that you summarize what was done for each article, the methods used, and describe the results. You don't have to understand all the statistics just have a good idea of what was done and what the results mean. Then compare the articles and discuss how they relate to each other.

The review should be 3-5 pages, double-spaced with a 12 pt. font, and 1" margins – concise, clear writing is a key part of the assignment, so length restrictions will be enforced!

Please turn in the articles you evaluated along with the review. Either electronic or hardcopy submission is ok. This assignment is due by midnight on Friday, June 6th. No late assignments will be accepted.
